What's included: 3 nights lodging in Hayward at the Lumberjack Steakhouse and Lodge, 3 days guided Musky fishing on some of the finest river Musky water in the country, lunches in the boat each day, a morning pickup at our motel by our guides, flies and terminal tackle.

Trip price per angler: \$1095.00 Cash or check made payable to Tight Lines Travel. This needs to be paid in full at least 2 weeks prior to the trip. A \$500.00 deposit is required at booking.

What's not included: Gratuity, current WI fishing license, breakfast and dinners (The motel has coffee and doughnuts in the morning), and Transportation to and from Hayward.

What to expect of the fishery: First and foremost, you will be fishing some of the most fabled Musky water in the world. The rivers are beautiful and the fish are amazing. This is by far one of the best opportunities a fly angler will have to catch a Musky on a fly. It is, however, not a sure thing. These are some of the most difficult fish to catch on a fly. You need to go into this with the mindset that a few follows or even one fish on the trip is a success. The fish do not come easy, but we can assure you they will be one of the most exciting fish you will catch.



The details:

We will be staying at the Lumberjack Steakhouse and Lodge in Hayward Wisconsin. Tight Lines has four rooms, non-smoking with two queen beds per room. When checking in, the rooms will be under Tight Lines.

Trip Date October 15,16,17,18

Arrive at the Lumberjack Steakhouse and Lodge October 15th after 2:00 pm. We will be staying the 15th, 16th, and 17th. Fish Oct. 16th, 17th, 18th and return home after fishing on the 18th.

What to bring:

RODS: Fast action 8, 9 or 10wt rods. I would bring a couple rods to have one as a backup. We will be throwing very large flies and need a rod that will work for this application. A great rod for these smaller rivers is the SAGE LARGEMOUTH Rod. It handles huge flies with ease.

FLY LINES: The RIO Power Fly and the Outbound short are shop favorites. I know that Larry and Wendy are also big fans of the SA Shark Skin. A few sinking leaders in the 7-9 Inch per second category will also work to convert any line with a welded loop into a sink tip.

REELS: Bring a reel big enough to hold a large line. The key is to have a good reel that will hold up and have some capacity to hold 9 and 10 wt fly lines.

CLOTHING: Northern Wisconsin can be cold in October. Plan for anything! Bring waders and wading boots (In case water is low and we need to get out of the boat) rain jacket, fleece gloves, and fleece tops for the mornings. I also like to bring a small dry bag in case it is raining.

OTHER GEAR: Polarized glasses (these are a must have! Big flies are flying around everyone's heads all day long), stripping fingers to decrease line burn, fishing hat, pliers for crimping barbs, camera, sunscreen, extra cash for guide gratuity, selection of flies and leaders, rain jacket(can't stress this enough).

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
